## Speech by Chief Guest:

Speech by Chief Guest **Dr.Jawad Rahim**. Judge, Principle Bench, National Green Tribunal, New Delhi delivered a thought-provoking speech on the necessity for conserving our environment as it is a gift to be passed on to our younger generation. Everyone of us has the onus to contribute our little mite to leave less carbon footprints, save water and to keep our air clean. His words of wisdom on conservation motivated the audience to live in harmony with nature. He urged the students to innovate and excel in technical research.

The Chief Guest emphasized the importance of segregating waste and not allowing biodegradable waste out of the house. He also stressed on the necessity of pooling cars. He advised the audience to switch over to LED lights as it reduces global warming because it releases less heat. The Chief Guest compared Nature to a beehive. As long as we don't harm

nature it remains benevolent to us. Once we touch the beehive, all the bees attack us. In the same way if we conserve and respect our Mother Nature, it gives it bounty to us.

Dr.Jawad Rahim also highlighted how the Green Tribunal gave landmark judgments to maintain the cleanliness of Ganga and Yamuna rivers. He talked of the poor air quality of Delhi and urged everyone to resist from bursting crackers. He emphasized the role of Green Tribunal in being stringent on the violators of environment.
